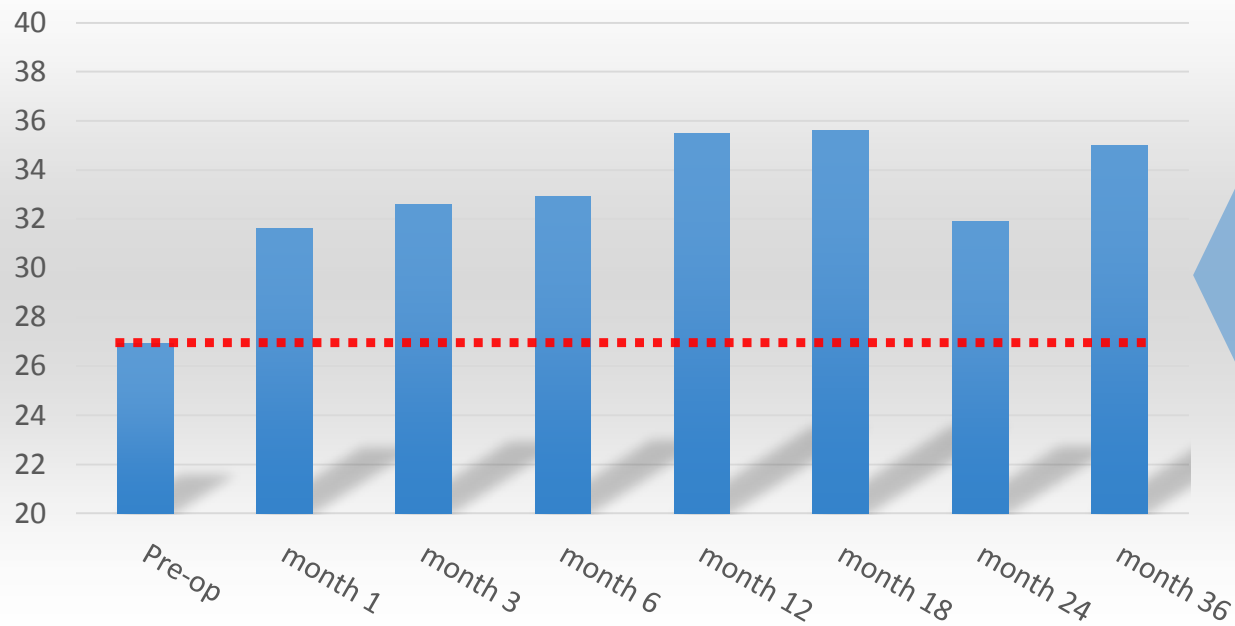

Caution-This is registry data collected as patients are treated, which is not the same as a randomized controlled trial typically used for FDA approval. In addition, later time points in this graph have more patients who did not answer questionnaires.

Oxford Hip Score



What's important?

This graph shows functional scores for an Oxford hip questionnaire given to patients before their procedure and at set time points after. In this graph, a higher bar means better hip function (like walking, climbing stairs, getting dressed, and the ability to perform household chores). The graph shows significant positive changes in function for most time points noted. Most of these patients were hip replacement candidates and Oxford [scores for a successful hip replacement are between 37-39.](#)

Details?

Mean age is 57.2 years old. BMI is 26.5. There were 154 women and 208 men. N is 241 at pre-treatment, 132 at 1 month, 144 at 3 months, 100 at 6 months, 57 at 12 months, 35 at 18 months, 24 at 24 months, 11 at 36 months.



Same Day Stem Cell Procedure

This procedure involves taking bone marrow stem cells from the back of the hip and re-injecting them under precise imaging guidance into the hip joint and associated structures like labrum.
