

Is PRP a DMOAD?

This infographic reviews randomized controlled trials that tested PRP used to treat knee osteoarthritis as a Disease Modifying Osteoarthritis Drug. The studies that showed that PRP improved the loss of cartilage thickness over time or slowed its loss are represented with a green triangle and the studies that failed to show that are in red triangles. The studies represented in triangles are placed along a PRP concentration graph with the Marx et al. definition of PRP as 2X shown.
